

2018 Education Award Program

The Tumour Foundation of BC has been providing educational scholarships to students in British Columbia, living with neurofibromatosis, since 2007. We are pleased to offer the program again this year to students currently attending or planning to attend, a post secondary institution of education or training. A minimum of two financial awards, valued at \$500 each, will be awarded annually. Funds may be use toward any post-secondary program and are applicable to the 2018-2019 academic year.

Submission deadline is June 30th. Successful applicants will be notified by August 1st, 2018.

Who is Eligible:

- British Columbians with neurofibromatosis that are Canadian citizens or have landed immigration status
- have applied to study, or are currently enrolled in a recognized educational program with the goal of increasing employability
- are at least 17 years of age by August 1st in the year of application
