The Tumour Foundation of BC has been providing educational scholarships to students in British Columbia, living with neurofibromatosis, since 2007. We are pleased to offer the program again this year to students currently attending or planning to attend, a post secondary institution of education or training. A minimum of two financial awards, valued at \$500 each, will be awarded annually. Funds may be use toward any post-secondary program within Canada and are applicable to the upcoming academic year.

Submissions are received throughout the year.

Who is Eligible:

- British Columbians with neurofibromatosis that are Canadian citizens or have landed immigration status.
- Individuals who have applied to study or are currently enrolled in a recognized Canadian post-secondary educational program with the goal of increasing employability.
- Individuals who are personally involved with the Tumour Foundation of BC or individuals whose families have been involved with the Tumour Foundation.
